

DEWORMING





How does usually pet get worms?

- Contact with soil or grass
- Scavenging & hunting
- Eating raw meat
- Fleas
- Eating feces
- Puppies & kittens can also contract worms from their mothers

Symptoms

- Scooting dragging the bottom on the floor
- Vomiting/Diarrhea
- Weight Loss
- Dull and lifeless coat
- Pot-bellied appearance
- Change in appetite





Worming Treatment Protocol

DOGS

Every 2 weeks until 3 months of age - (worming syrup to be given for 2 consecutive days)

Monthly until 6 months of age (tablet)

Every 3 months (especially if you have children at home)

CATS

Every 2 weeks until 3 months of age - (worming syrup to be given for 2 consecutive days)

Monthly until 6 months of age (tablet)

Every 3 months (outdoor cat) or every 6 months for purely indoor cat

Flea & Ticks Treatment Protocol

Spot-On Solution - could be started as early as 7-8 weeks of age; to be given or applied monthly

Tablet - could be started as early as 7-8 weeks of age; to be given every 3 months orally
